The Back to Batoche Festival is seeking a qualified contractor for **SECURITY** services for the event. The Back to Batoche Festival is held **July 16-19, 2026** at Batoche SK. This event is of vital importance to the Métis people from across Canada and the homeland. The vendor is asked to submit a proposal for the following:

Supplies and duties include but are not limited to:

- Provide 24 hour, on site security services beginning Monday July 13, 2026 at 07:00AM to Monday July 20, 2026 at 11:59PM
- Successful tender must be security certified and trained
- Thirty (30) security officers to be provided – 20 to cover from 7 am – 11 pm, ten (10) from 11 pm – 7 am
- List of scheduled shifts must be provided and number of staff to be included in the bid
- Areas of service: front and exit gates, main pavilion, second stage, rodeo grounds, traditional camp, ball diamond, sport's area, kid's ville, artisan market, buffalo fence
- Golf carts provided – two active at all times, 24 hours a day
- 20 radios provided
- All staff must be radio equipped (provided) and wearing security vests
- General duties include keeping the peace, assisting visitors as required, ensuring the event remains drug and alcohol free including visual vehicle searches at the entrance
- Recording after hours admissions and reporting to gate staff in the morning
- Communication strategy to the RCMP and EMT will be provided
