We play with toys.



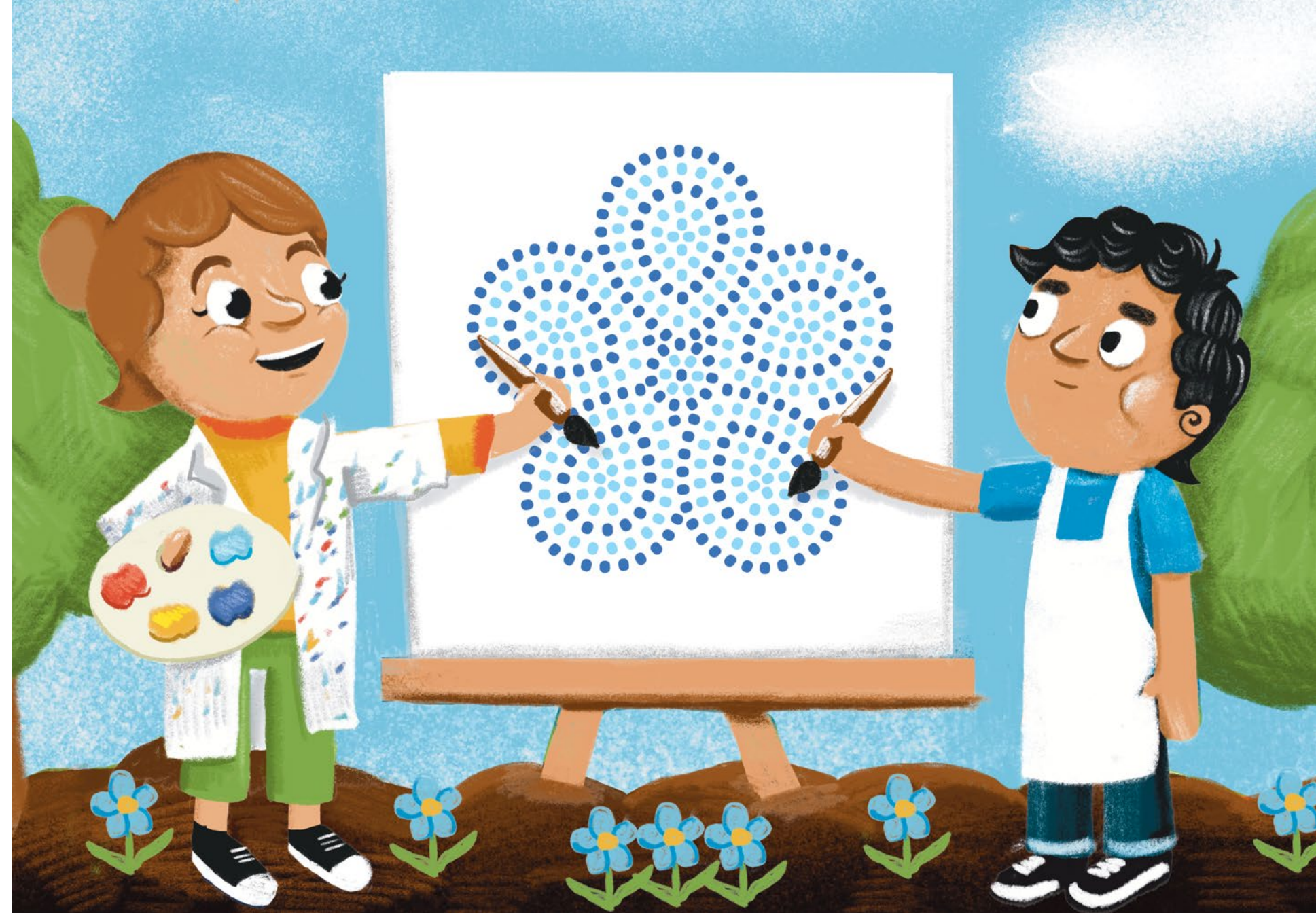
Nimasinahigēpicigānān.
